

Accommodation

There are many small hotels in the vicinity of the university and close by public transportation. A few are listed below.

Alamo Guest House – Friendly guest house alongside Kelvingrove Park and only a 10-15 minute walk from the university. <http://www.alamoguesthouse.com/>

The Belhaven – About a 10-minute walk from the university, guest lecturers often stay here. <http://www.belhavenhotel.com/>

Kirklee Hotel – About a 10-minute walk from the university, this is a small but very friendly hotel. <http://www.kirkleehotel.co.uk/>

The Clifton Hotel – About a 10-minute walk from the university, on Great Western Road. www.cliftonhotelglasgow.co.uk

Transportation

Underground – The university stop is at Hillhead. The major stops in city centre are Buchanan Street (Queen Street Station) and St Enoch (Central Station). Don't worry about getting lost: the Glasgow underground runs in a circle so you don't have to worry about getting lost. <http://www.spt.co.uk/subway/>

Taxi – There is a taxi stand on Byres Road just outside Hillhead station. Taxis also can be flagged down fairly easily along any of the major streets in the area.
